




Planning Policy Wales

National policy outlining guidance for making planning decisions

Circular 001/2020 – Town and Country Planning (Major Residential Development) (Notification) (Wales) Direction 2020

Requires Local Planning Authorities (LPAs) to "refer applications to the Welsh Ministers where they are minded to grant planning permission for residential development of 10 or more residential units or residential development on 0.5 hectares or more of land, which is not in accordance with one or more provisions of the development plan in force".



Strategic Development Plans

Consultation ended 4th of January 2021

Work will start on SDP regulations in Spring 2021

SDP regulations hoping to come into force

Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council

Adopted LDP 2006-2021.

Replacement LDP (RLDP) 2018-2033 not yet adopted.

Consulting on the RLDP Second Call for Candidate Sites (currently suspended due to Tier 4).

All comments on the findings to the Second Call for Candidate Sites to be submitted by 2nd of February 2021 (likely to be extended due to Tier 4 restrictions).



Bridgend County Borough Council

Adopted LDP 2006-2021. RLDP 2018-2033 not yet adopted.


Requested to amend their Delivery Agreement (DA) due to Covid-19 pandemic. Formal extension resulting in a delay of 6 months in consulting on the Deposit Plan with submission for examination in September 2021 and adoption anticipated in Spring 2022.



Caerphilly County Borough Council

Adopted LDP 2006-2021. RLDP up to 2035 not yet adopted.

Canceled the 2nd RLDP Draft Delivery Agreement consultation due to Covid-19. Not progressing any further until the Covid-19 crisis has ended



Cardiff Council

Adopted LDP 2006-2021. RLDP 2021-2036 not yet adopted.

The Full Review process of the LDP (which initially took place in December 2019) is being restarted.

Draft Review Report and Draft Delivery agreement is subject to a 4-week consultation period (7th January – 4th of February 2021).




Carmarthenshire County Council

Key Stage 5 (submission of LDP to WG for examination due to take place in May 2021)



Not yet reached the deposit stage of development.



Next stage is to prepare the Deposit Plan.





Adopted the RLDP 2016-2031 on the 29th of January 2020.




Monmouthshire County Council

Adopted LDP 2011-2026.



November 2020. Candidate Site Stage in June-Sept 2021.




Pembrokeshire County Council

In Spring 2021, a report listing the comments made on the Deposit Plan and officer response will be presented to Full Council.




