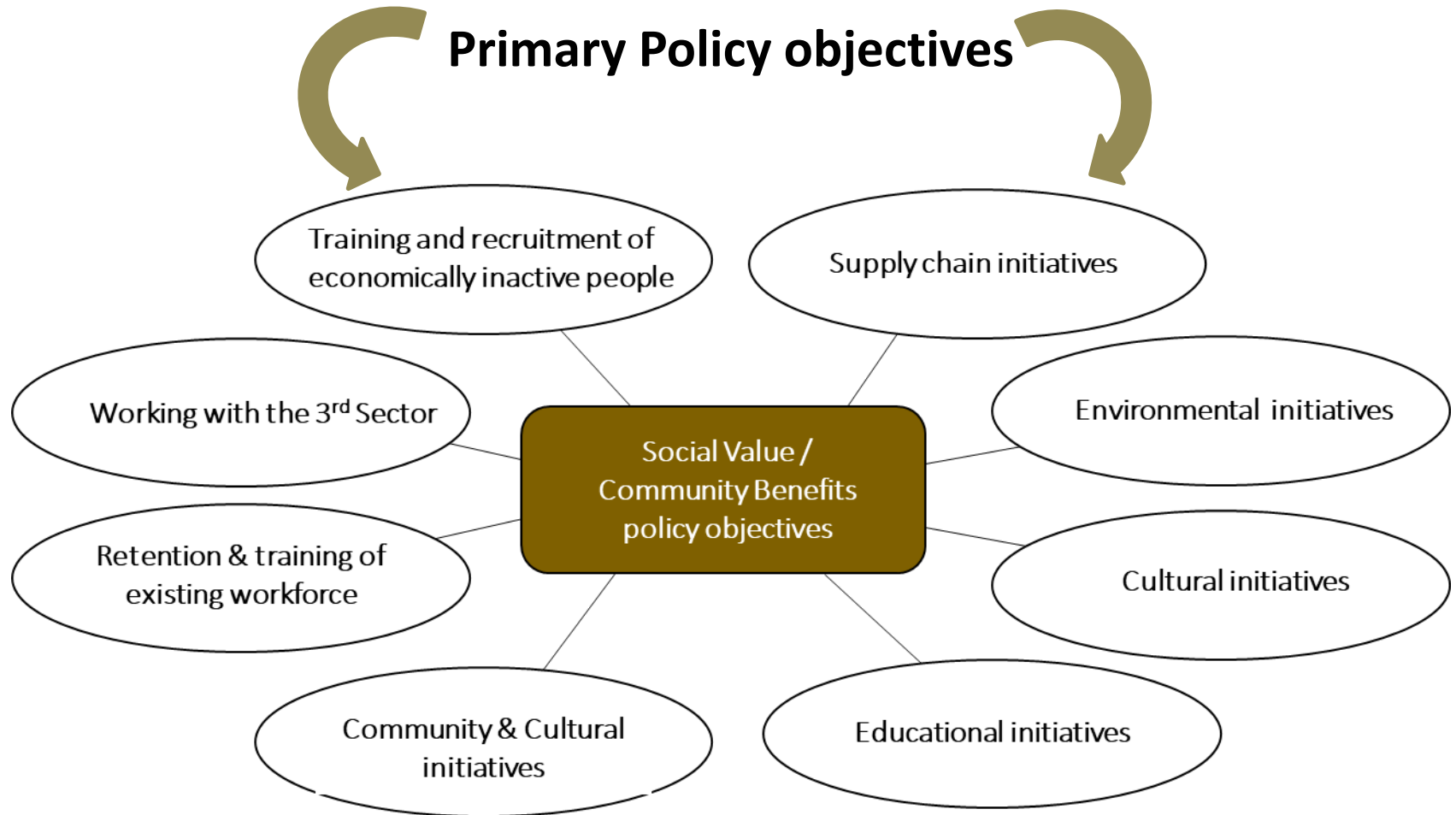

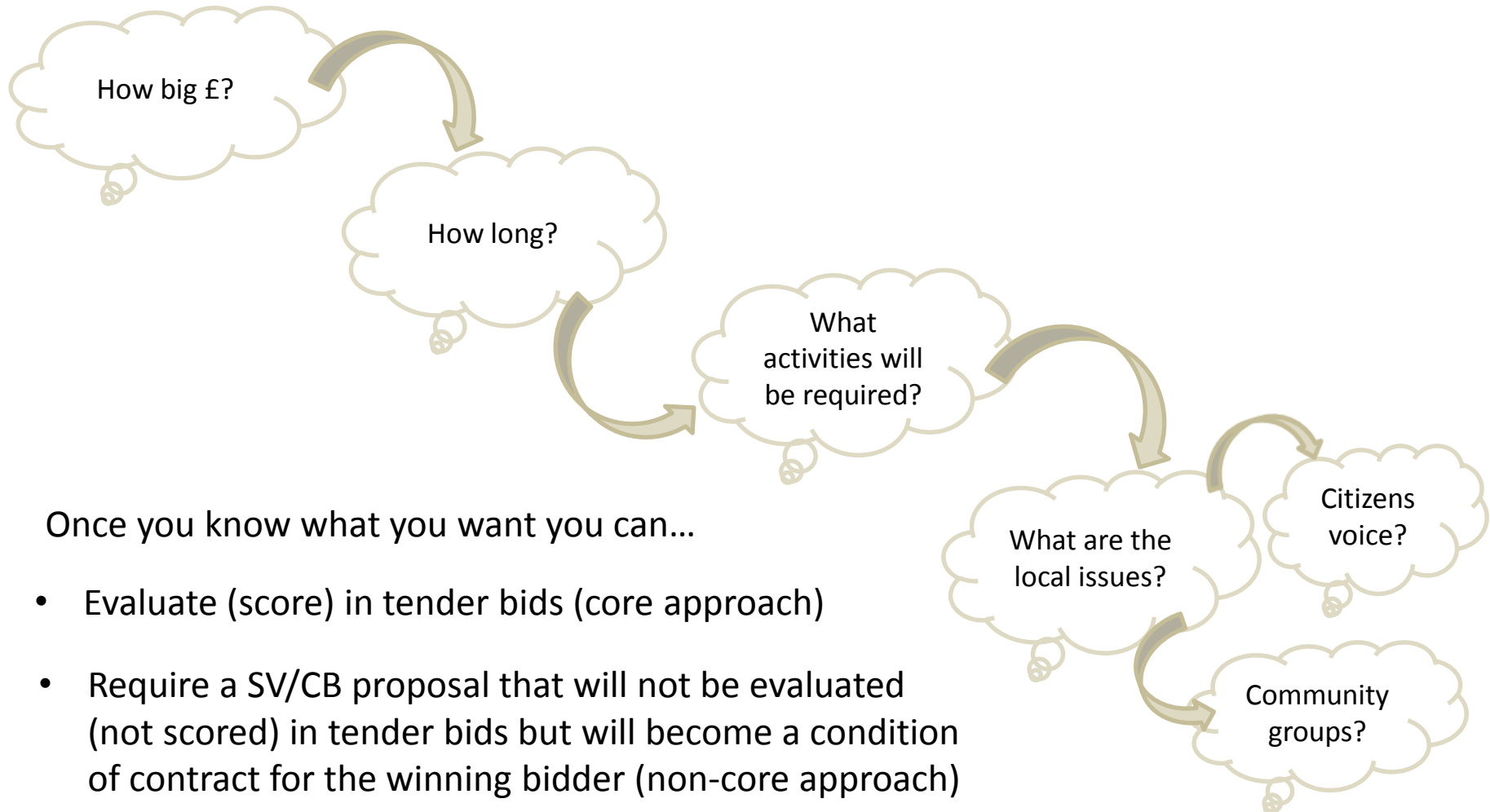

# Recording / reporting outcomes

## Community Benefits Measurement Tool (CBMT)

### Development brief (2009)

- Free to use
- Focused on data/information readily to hand
- To allow reporting of the socio-economic impact of public sector projects

And more recently;

- To allow reporting against WBFG Act 'goals'



# Recording / reporting outcomes

## What does the CBMT cover?

- **Contract Header details...** project title, duration, contact points
- **General** – spend split between goods, services & overheads (GSO) and staff/labour (SL)
- **Supply chain** – breakdown spend, with SMEs, Third Sector orgs
- **Employment** – staff retained, disadvantaged people employed
- **Environment** – landfill avoided , recycled materials, water saving,
- **Community and Education** – support of community projects, STEM activities
- **Culture (Language, culture and sport)** – ‘protection, promotion, participation’
- **Training** – Apprenticeships to Volunteering
- **Sign Off** – Client / Employer and Contractor confirm outcomes reported
- **Results pages** - summarise results as outcomes / WFG Goal outcomes
