

Welfare Strategic Delivery Group Terms of Reference

CHC's Strategic Delivery Groups (SDGs) actively support a strong and resilient sector and support the lobbying and advocacy work on issues identified by the membership through CHC's Corporate Plan.

Purpose

The Welfare SDG will:

- Test and develop policy ideas
- Respond to, shape and influence government and stakeholder policy ideas
- Horizon scan to identify future risks and opportunities
- Feed into and shape CHC conferences and training so that they are relevant and beneficial for members

Remit

In 2021/22, this SDG will focus on the following priority areas (as identified by the sector):

- Monitoring and managing the impact of Covid-19 on HA welfare support
- Measuring the impact of Universal Credit
- Influencing the delivery of social security in Wales
- Joint working with the Housing Management SDG
- Developing CHC and Four Federations lobbying priorities

The Chief Executives and Housing Association Chairs & Vice Chairs SDGs may commission pieces of work from this SDG.

SDG Chair & Vice Chair

The Chairs & Vice Chairs of the SDGs are appointed following an election process. Their current term will end in April 2022.

SDG Meetings

- Attendance to SDG meetings is free as part of the CHC membership package
- Each Housing Association will determine which members of staff should attend the meetings of each SDG
- SDGs will run once every quarter. The dates for 2021/22 have been set in advance and are available [here](#).
- All SDG meetings are virtual. They will be held on Zoom and joining instructions will be circulated the day before the meeting.
- An agenda for each meeting will be circulated at least one week in advance
- There will be an agenda item at the end of each SDG to self-evaluate
- CHC staff will provide admin and tech support for each meeting
- Outcomes and progress from each SDG will be reported to the CHC Board and shared with the rest of the sector
