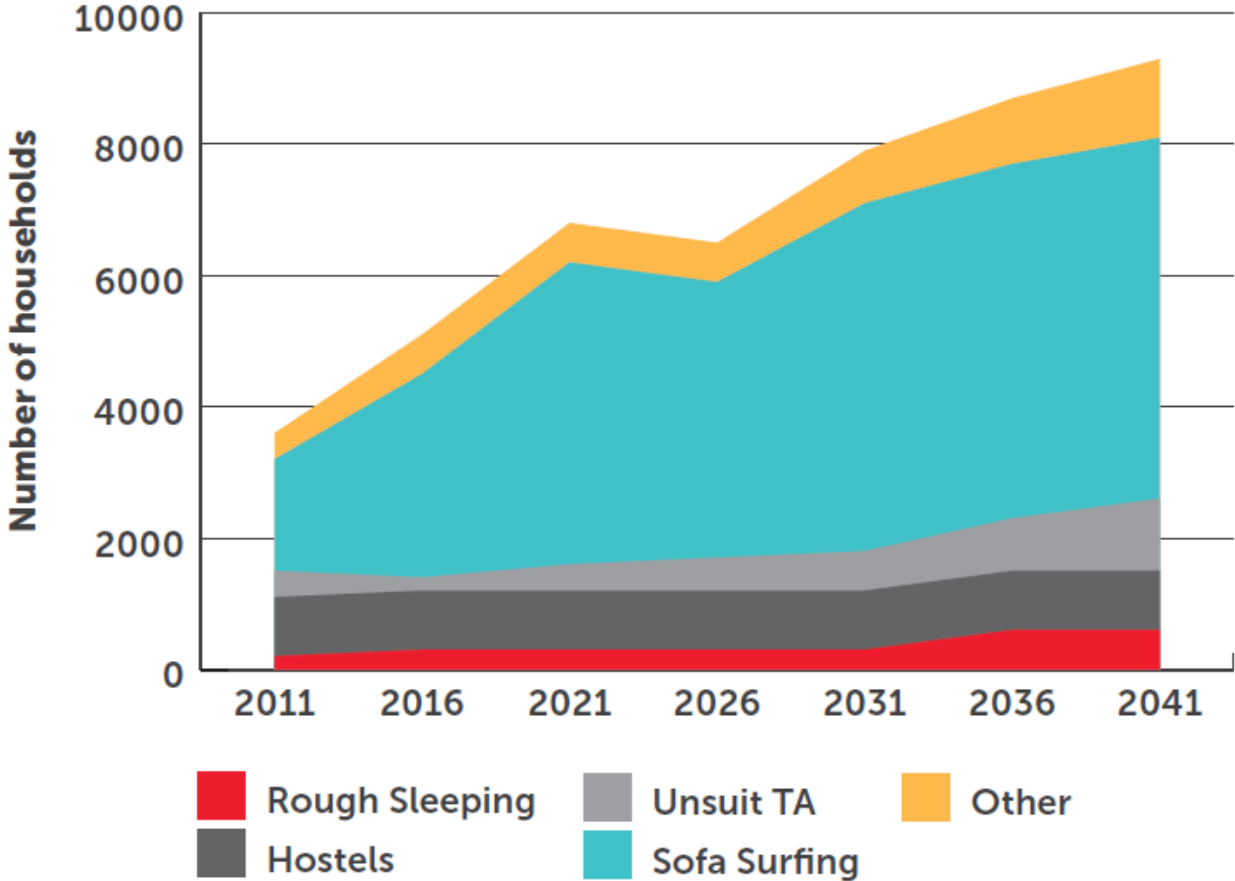

# A definition of ending homelessness

1. No one sleeping rough
2. No one living in emergency accommodation, such as shelters and hostels without a plan to rapidly rehouse them into affordable, secure and decent accommodation
3. No one forced to live in transient or dangerous accommodation, such as tents, squats and non-residential buildings
4. No one homeless as a result of leaving a state institution, such as prison or the care system
5. Everyone at immediate risk of homelessness gets the help they need that prevents it happening.
