Ministry of Justice (Jackson) Reforms...



Largest overhaul of personal injuries legal framework in over 10 years designed to:

- Tackle the compensation culture
- Make lawyers costs proportionate to the value of claims
- Improve efficiency strict time frames and eportal
- Create a framework for insurers to pass savings to customers









- Concerns about the disproportionate level of civil litigation costs led to Lord Jackson being asked to conduct a review
- In December 2009 Lord Jackson's Final Report was produced in respect of Civil Litigation Costs
- The report proposed 'a coherent package of interlocking reforms, designed to control costs and promote access to justice'
- Primarily changes recommended are due to enter law by way of proposed changes to Civil Procedure Rules – Portal for Employers and Public Liability claims – 1st August

- According to Lord Jackson's report the expected outcomes of the changes are:
 - Most personal injury claimants will recover more damages than they do at present, although some will recover less
 - Claimants will have a financial interest in the level of costs which are being incurred on their behalf
 - Claimant solicitors will still be able to make a reasonable profit
 - Costs payable to claimant solicitors by liability insurers will be significantly reduced
 - Costs will also become more proportionate, because defendants will no longer have to pay success fees and ATE insurance premiums





Referral fees ban

QOCS (Qualified one way cost shifting)

10% increase in General damages



Success fees / ATE's no longer recoverable

Success fee limited to 25%

Legal costs proportionate to value of damage

Fixed costs in Fast Track injury cases

Significantly reduced timeframes

Employers Liability reduced from 90 to 30 days Public Liability reduced from 90 to 40 days

- Notify actual or potential claims immediately
