
Analysis of Housing Association WHQS Statistical Returns


A sample of anonymised outputs from data analysis identifying trends and patterns across:


- Non-compliance
- Acceptable Fails (AFs)
- 'Full compliance' (i.e. not subject to any AFs)
- Individual HAs
- HA type (Traditional vs LSVT)
- Components (e.g. electrical, energy rating)
- Over time (2013/14 2017/18)
 - 2018/19 data release expected 3rd Oct 2019


NB: All analysis refers to HAs with 250+ units in their current housing stock only.


















The highest rates of Non-Compliance are found in:


- Trad 16 17% (13% AFs)
- Trad 19 11% (28% AFs)
- LSVT 1 8% (37% AFs)





This chart presents 2017/18 rates of compliance with interesting and diverse dynamics.


- Trad 8 has a very high level of AFs, but only 1% non-compliance
- Trad 16 has 70% compliance and 13% AFs but 17% non-compliance (highest in the sector)
- Trad 17, Trad 21 and Trad 4 all have high AF levels, but report no non-compliance at all











To Consider – Your HA

- Your HA's process, from data collection to reporting:
 - Who is involved?
 - How and where is data held (system, spreadsheet, exports)?
 - How reliable and resilient are these systems?
 - How much independent scrutiny is there of interpretation of guidance? When?
 - How much independent verification is there of the data? When?

To Consider – The Sector

- Checks and balances for WHQS data
 - Role of the Board
 - Policies and procedures
 - Scrutiny of annually reviewed Compliance policy
- What will that mean for WHQS now and in the future; for your HA and the sector?
- What does this mean for the assurance of other data (statutory elements such as gas and electric)?
